4. Budget Requests

A. \$62.3 million for Older Californians Act

- Consider approval to join C4A in advocating for a \$62.3 million annual investment that includes the following:
 - \$37 million (About 59%) – Nutrition Services Home-

delivered and congregate meals that address food insecurity, support health stability, and reduce costly institutional care.

- \$15.66 million (about 25%) – Information and Assistance (I&A) Statewide access, navigation, coordination, and case management.
- \$10.44 million (about 16%) – Caregiver Support Services that stabilize caregivers, reduce burnout, and prevent unnecessary institutionalization.
