## David Campos Appointed to the CA Commission on Aging

SACRAMENTO --- Anthony Rendon, the former Speaker of the California State Assembly, as one of his final acts before his term with the Assembly expired on June 30, appointed David Campos to the California Commission on Aging (CCoA) on June 28, 2023.

The new Commissioner, Attorney David Campos, works for the County of Santa Clara where, among other things, he oversees the county's legislative affairs. Campos has served as Vice-Chair of the California Democratic Party since his election in 2021. He brings to the Commission experience in addressing homelessness and housing, one of CCoA's policy priorities, and a background in advocating for equity, social justice, and expanded access to healthcare.

Commissioner Campos has more than two decades of public service, having previously held office as a San Francisco Board of Supervisors member, a San Francisco Police Commissioner, a General Counsel of San Francisco's public schools, and a Deputy City Attorney. He holds a law degree from Harvard Law.
