

## Commissioners participate in State Plan on Aging Hearing

The California Department of Aging (CDA) must submit a State Plan to the federal Administration on Aging (AoA) every four years to receive federal Older American Act (OAA) funds. These federal funds are matched with State and local funds and allocated to the 33 Area Agencies on Aging (AAA) to provide OAA programs and services.

The final version of the California State Plan on Aging – 2017-2021 that is approved by the AoA will be posted on CDA's website by September 30, 2017.
