- Grants are available to students from San Bernardino and Riverside counties
- Applications due March 2, 2027
- \$2,500 for eligible gerontology minors
- \$5,000 for eligible gerontology majors
- Freshman, sophomore, junior, senior, and graduate students
- Recipients can reapply for up to four years, depending on additional funding
